Bergamo **UNESCO Creative City**

The perfect square in the heart of Bergamo Alta, and intact walls, a World Heritage Site. Yet, the city at the foot of the Orobic Prealps is a perfect mix of history, culture and contemporaneity. An unmissable stop is the Donizetti Museum with the life, work and personality of the great composer who was the protagonist of the early nineteenth century European musical theater.



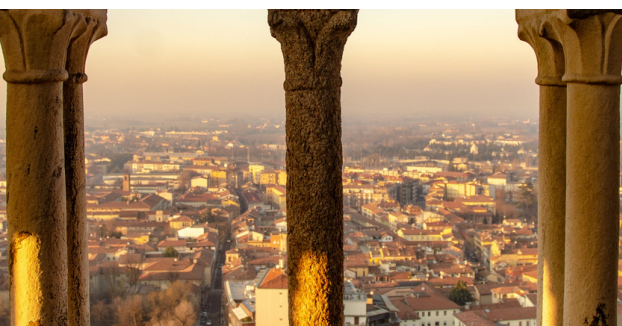
Brescia **"Longobarda" City**

An ancient city with the Roman remains of the "Brixia" and with a medieval soul. City symbol: The Clock Tower, with the astronomical dial. The medieval district of Carmine with Indian groceries alongside university copy shops. Brescia, a rich city famous for food and wine, is part of the "Strada del Franciacorta", a territory preserved by the skill of the winemakers who still today harvest strictly by hand!



Como **Alessandro Volta City**

Como is famous all over the world for the lake of the same name and is considered the "city of light" for its indissoluble bond with the great physicist who invented the battery Alessandro Volta, his hometown. Also famous for its silk factories, for the "cafes" under the arcades, and for its long lake!



Cremona **Capital of Music**

Cremona, a typical Italian provincial town with a lot of history and culture. Defined as the small capital of music, with the Violin Museum, the Arvedi Auditorium, the Ponchielli Theater, the workshops of master luthiers and a UNESCO World Heritage Site.



Lecco **Manzoni City**

Nestled on the left branch of Lake Como, Lecco is a small town-village with a beautiful lakeside promenade. The bond with the great writer Alessandro Manzoni and with the places of his famous "Promessi Sposi" is so strong that it is hard to separate literature and reality in Lecco. An example is Villa Manzoni, the neoclassical residence of the writer's family, which is the most visited literary museum in Lombardy!

Lodi

City of Federico Barbarossa

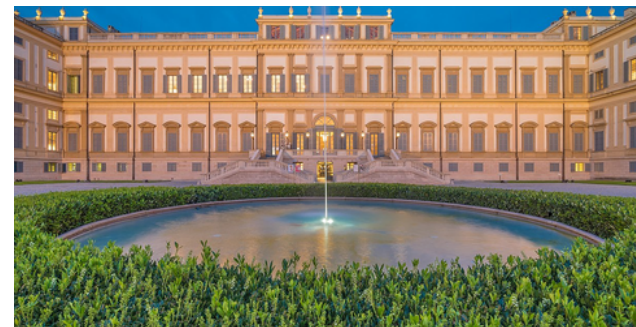
Middle Ages, Renaissance, Art Nouveau, modernity and food and wine are the words that fully represent the small city-province of Lodi. The past bears the name of Federico Barbarossa, the famous emperor of the "Longobardi". The present is that of the famous architect Renzo Piano, who conceived the space of a private bank as a space for sharing, with an auditorium and a covered square.



Monza

Royal City

Monza, the emblem of the city: the Royal Villa commissioned in 1777 by Ferdinand of Habsburg as a country residence, the Royal Villa of Monza is one of the wonders created by Piermarini. A city at double speed: that of the Formula 1 racetrack opposed to the rhythm of runners in the Parco della Villa, the largest enclosed green lung in Europe.



Pavia

University City

A city with ancient traditions, Pavia is wisdom, pride and tradition. From its ancient University have passed writers, scientists, inventors. Leonardo Da Vinci made a contribution to the design of the Duomo. In its main churches we find the remains of saints and kings. Symbol of the city is the covered bridge that spans the Ticino river, where you will find a plaque dedicated to the 50th anniversary of the death of Albert Einstein, who lived here for a while.



Varese

The Garden City

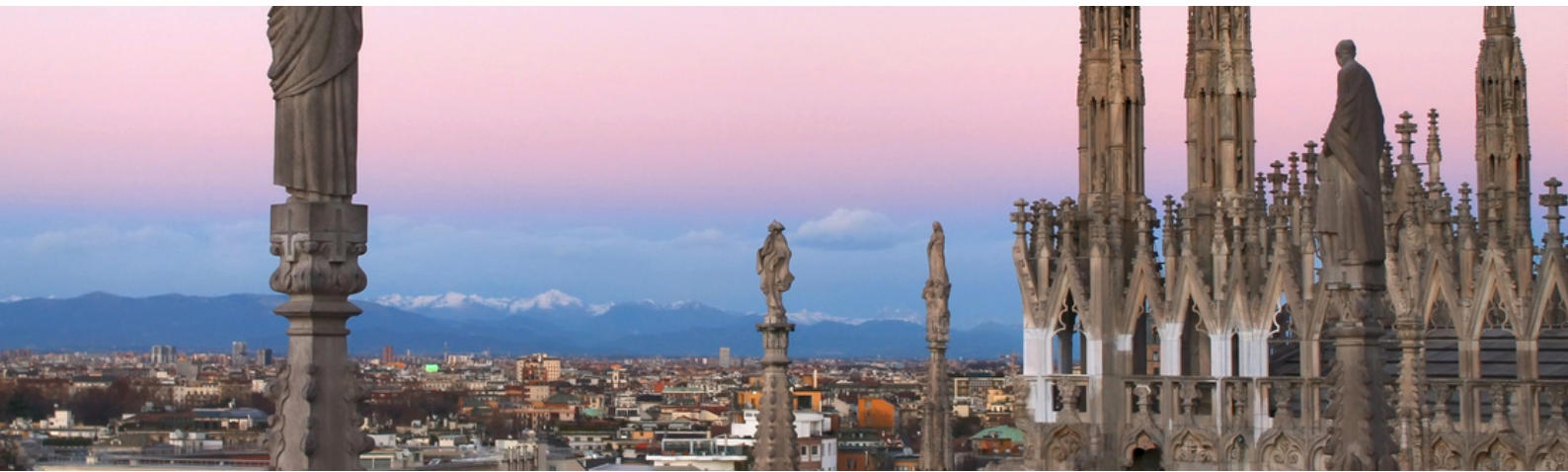
Varese, known as the garden city or small Versailles. Its parks surround the villas of the city; "green lungs" and flower beds announce the beauty of Palazzo Estense with its Italian-style gardens and the rigorous cutting of the hedges. Outside the city, there is still nature with Lake Varese for lovers of trekking and cycling and the Parco dei Fiori with the "Sacro Monte", a UNESCO World Heritage Site, which includes 14 seventeenth-century chapels.

TOUR CHIC MILANO

6 days - 5 nights



Milano, as introverted and discreet as its inhabitants, has been transformed in the last 30 years into the capital of fashion, innovation, design and futuristic architectural projects.

After the 2015 EXPO, Milano experienced an unprecedented tourist boom, becoming the second most visited Italian city after Rome, thus making it known all over the world for its artistic, historical and museum beauties. An unmissable city for anyone visiting Italy!



DAY 1 | MILANO, LOMBARDIA

Meet & Greet and private transfer. Accommodation at the Mandarin Oriental Milano hotel or similar, free afternoon. We recommend a walk along the arcades of Via Vittorio Emanuele until you reach the Gallery of the same name, the Duomo and Piazza La Scala with its famous theater. Before dinner, a classic appointment for the Milanese is to meet for an aperitif in the trendiest neighborhoods of the city, with lots of clubs. Don't miss the central area of the Duomo with its panoramic terraces.



DAY 2 | CITY TOUR

After breakfast, a private city tour of the historic and modern districts of Milano: City Life Tre Torri designed by the architects Daniel Libeskind, Arata Isozaki and Zaha Hadid, is one of the most prestigious and futuristic projects in Milano. The new skyscrapers of Porta Nuova, Piazza Gae Aulenti, the floral profile of the Vertical Forest. For lunch we recommend Eataly Milano Smeraldo, a historic Milanese theater transformed into a large restaurant corner with the specialties of all Italian cuisine. The Mediterranean diet is officially included in the UNESCO Intangible Cultural Heritage List!

TOUR CHIC MILANO

6 days - 5 nights

In the afternoon visit the UNESCO site: the masterpiece “L’Ultima Cena” (“Last Supper”) by Leonardo da Vinci, the Church of Santa Maria delle Grazie and the adjacent convent. At the end, return to the hotel and for the evening we recommend dinner and a walk in the Darsena in the Navigli district.

DAY 3 | BRERA ART GALLERY

Breakfast at hotel. Visit the Pinacoteca di Brera, built in 1776 as an Academy of Fine Arts commissioned by Maria Theresa of Austria, then reigning in Lombardy. The Pinacoteca is a museum of great importance, considered a true cultural and artistic core with several institutes: the museum with the collections of the great Renaissance painters, the Brera Academy, the Braidense library among the major Italian libraries, the museum and astronomical observatory, the botanical garden, the media library, the Lombard Institute of the Academy of Sciences and Letters. For lunch it is advisable to stop in one of the many typical restaurants of the Brera district, with its small and characteristic pedestrian streets. From the Brera District, turning onto Via Brera, you can reach the Castello Sforzesco for a pleasant walk through its gardens or for a guided tour.

DAY 4 | DUOMO AND DUOMO MUSEUM

Breakfast at hotel. Day to be dedicated to visiting the Duomo and its Museum: born from the idea of enhancing and not wasting all the material used or discarded for the design as well as for the realization. In the immediate vicinity, if you want to indulge in a quick “street food” lunch, we recommend tasting the legendary Luini panzerotto, an Apulian specialty that has become a real culinary icon! In the afternoon, walk in the “fashion district”, the heart of Milano for shopping: via Monte Napoleone, Via della Spiga, Via Manzoni and Corso Venezia, with the brands that have made fashion and fashion made in Italy famous throughout the world. For dinner, one of the experiences to have when visiting a city is to taste its typical dishes. Milano created in 2006 the DeCa brand, Denomination of Ambrosiana Cuisine. The project identifies a list of typical dishes of the Milano area and province, made in such a way as to enhance the products of the territory in compliance with the correct methods of cooking and processing the ingredients, to certify those who practice True Milanese Cuisine.

6 days - 5 nights



DAY 5 | MILANO AND DESIGN

Breakfast at hotel. Design is an integral part of the culture of Milano and Lombardia. A dense network of public and business museums, studios and private archives testifies to the importance of its history for the city's heritage. Our itinerary starts from a new museum that combines past and future. Inaugurated in May 2021, in Via Ceresio 7 near the Monumental, the ADI Design Museum is a large exhibition of objects awarded with the Compasso D'Oro ADI - the prestigious Italian design award.



For a design lunch we recommend the terrace of the historic Enel building where the Ceresio 7 restaurant is located, an absolutely innovative project. In the afternoon, visit the Triennale building, where since 9 April 2019 the Museum of Italian Design has presented a selection of the most iconic and representative pieces of Italian design in a permanent setting.

For those who are passionate about architecture, it is advisable not to miss the Franco Albini Foundation, which houses the archive of the "craftsman" architect. Franco Albini was one of the most important and rigorous Italian architects of the twentieth century, adhering to Italian Rationalism. He has marked the history of Italian and international architecture with that multidisciplinary attitude in which the three disciplinary dimensions of industrial design, architecture and urban planning merge.



For an exceptional evening, we recommend dinner at the Enrico Bartolini restaurant at Mudec, which, after the great Gualtiero Marchese, has managed to obtain three Michelin stars. His restaurant presents a modern and sophisticated menu that encompasses the flavors of good food, with dishes that look like real works of art with attention to every detail, all in a special location: Mudec, which is a large exhibition space designed by the famous British architect David Chipperfield.



DAY 6 | MILANO

Breakfast at hotel. Last look at the city, free time. Transfer to the airport.

TOUR UNESCO

8 days - 7 nights



Lombardia is the Italian region that boasts the highest concentration of sites in the World Heritage List: 10 UNESCO sites, plus 3 intangible heritages to protect: ancient luthier art of Cremona, Bergamo UNESCO Creative City for Gastronomy and Milano for Literature.

DAY 1 | MILANO, LOMBARDIA

Meet & Greet and private transfer. Accommodation at the Mandarin Oriental Milano hotel or similar, free afternoon. We recommend a walk along the arcades of Via Vittorio Emanuele until you reach the Gallery of the same name, the Duomo and Piazza La Scala with its famous theater. TOUR UNESCO

8 days - 7 nights



DAY 3 | BERGAMO, UNESCO CREATIVE CITY

Breakfast at hotel. Private tour of Bergamo, UNESCO site, with the most beautiful square in Europe! Located on a hill, enclosed by a wall with four gates, the Upper Town welcomes, at first glance, with a tangle of hidden courtyards, craft shops, arcades and long shadows. Lunch in a typical restaurant. In the Lower Town, the 1920s architecture by Marcello Piacentini. The city opens up to the new in the Gallery of Modern and Contemporary Art, GAMEC, which houses, among other things, the Spajani, Manzù and Stucchi collections. Visit the Basilica of Santa Maria Maggiore to admire one of Lorenzo Lotto's masterpieces, or better still in the Carrara Academy, where works by Beato Angelico, Botticelli, Bellini, Mantegna, Titian and Rubens are kept. Return to Milan in the late afternoon.



DAY 4 | MILANO, MUSEUMS AND BASILICAS

Breakfast at hotel. Free day to deepen the visit of the city: Duomo, Sforzesco Castle, Brera Art Gallery, Basilica of Sant'Ambrogio, Basilica of Sant'Eustorgio...Do not miss the excellent museums of the city including: National Science Museum and "Leonardo da Vinci" technology, Italian Design Museum, Duomo Museum, Rondanini Pietà Museum, Ambrosiana Art Gallery, Manzoni's House - Manzoniano Museum ... for its beauty and the lively nightlife that characterizes it.



DAY 5 | MANTOVA, UNESCO HERITAGE

After breakfast, departure for the wonderful Renaissance city, the most important in Europe: Mantua, the City of the Gonzaga, UNESCO Heritage and Italian Capital of Culture 2016. Visit with a private guide the historic center with a walking itinerary that leads to the discovery of the rich artistic heritage and cultural heritage that characterizes the city. In the evening we suggest a short cruise among the lakes of Mantova, to discover a city that, at sunset, becomes romantic and mysterious.

TOUR UNESCO

8 days - 7 nights

DAY 6 | MANTOVA, UNESCO HERITAGE

Breakfast at hotel. Guided tour of the Doge's Palace and Palazzo Te. In the afternoon we suggest dedicating some free time to discovering the city, walking along the streets of the center and letting yourself be enchanted by churches and monuments that surprise at every corner.



DAY 7 | MANTOVA - SABBIONETA, UNESCO HERITAGE

Breakfast at hotel. Departure for Sabbioneta, defined as the "Ideal City" of the Renaissance, where art, architecture and urban planning represent the highest expression of the classicism that has influenced and shaped the whole of Europe. Sabbioneta was built in about thirty-five years by the will of Prince Vespasiano Gonzaga. Private visit of the Synagogue, the Doge's Palace, the Olympic Theater, the Garden Palace, the Gallery of the Ancients and the B.V. Crowned.



DAY 8 | SABBIONETA, UNESCO HERITAGE - MILANO

After breakfast, departure to the airport.

TREMEZZO AND THE HISTORIC VILLAS

3 days / 2 nights



The Americans gave it the name of "Lake Time" alluding to the slow pace, the suspension of time, the haste that disappears. Sudden relaxation.



DAY 1 | MILANO - CERNOBBIO - TREMEZZO

Departure from Milano by private car towards Tremezzo: listed among the most beautiful villages of Lake Lario (Lake Como) and awarded with the "one of the most beautiful villages in Italy" label. On the way stop in Cernobbio and visit Villa Bernasconi, one of the rare examples of Liberty architecture on Lake Como. Arrival and accommodation at the Grand Hotel Tremezzo.



DAY 2 | TREMEZZO

Breakfast at hotel. Visit of Villa Carlotta built at the end of the seventeenth century by the Marquis Clerici of Milano, the Villa contains wonders of nature and a museum with great artistic collections.

Afternoon dedicated to relaxation.



DAY 3 | TREMEZZO - MILANO

Breakfast at hotel. "Riva" motorboat ride, a timeless experience, to try the real Italian "Dolce Vita". Return to Milan in the afternoon.

SIRMIONE THE PEARL OF GARDA

3 days / 2 nights



DAY 1 | MILANO – SIRMIONE

Departure from Milano by private car, arrival in Sirmione: a village with an ancient charm between architectural beauties and suggestive naturalistic corners. During the journey, a short stop in Desenzano, in the afternoon continuation to Sirmione, accommodation at the Grand Hotel Terme or similar.



DAY 2 | SIRMIONE

Breakfast at hotel. Visit of Sirmione with the precious sacred buildings and the many local monuments, from the Roman remains of the Grotte di Catullo to the early medieval testimonies such as the Church of San Salvatore, from the Scaligero Castle to Palazzo Callas, in an animated annual calendar of cultural events, music, poetry and photography. Return to the hotel in the late afternoon.



DAY 3 | SIRMIONE - TORRE DEL BENACO - MILANO

Breakfast at hotel. Drive by car along the Veneto shore of Lake Garda, we will cross Lazise, Bardolino up to Torre del Benaco, stop and visit the village. Return to Milano in the evening.



STRESA AND THE BORROMEAN ISLANDS

3 days / 2 nights



DAY 1 | MILANO – STRESA

Departure from Milano to Stresa with your private car and driver. Stroll the beautiful centre of Stresa, full of shops, cafés and restaurants evoking the atmosphere of the Belle Époque which illustrious travellers like Stendhal, Chateaubriand, Dumas, Dickens and Lord Byron described in their writings. Visit the park of Villa Pallavicino. Settle in your lakeside hotel.



DAY 2 | STRESA – ISOLE BORROMEO – STRESA

After breakfast, leave your hotel and embark on a boat to visit the 3 Borromeo islands, with your private guide. Isola Bella is entirely filled by the sumptuous 17th-century summer palace of Count Vitaliano Borromeo and its over-the-top terraced gardens. Continue to Isola Madre and the fishing village on Isola dei Pescatori. Return to Stresa for the evening.



DAY 3 | STRESA – MILAN

After breakfast we visit Villa Taranto. Lake Maggiore is famous for its flowers and gardens: a visit to the Gardens of Villa Taranto in Pallanza is not to be missed, and rightly considered one of the most beautiful botanical parks in the world. Return to Milano in late afternoon.

Isle Borromeo are open to visits from spring to autumn.

COMO AND BELLAGIO

3 days / 2 nights



DAY 1 | COMO - BLEVIO

Departure from Milano by private car, arrival in Como: a small pantheon on the shores of the lake, dedicated to Alessandro Volta, collects the tools of his first experiments, inventor of the first electric generator ever made, the battery, and discoverer of methane gas. Private tour of the “Voltiana” city with local guide. At the end continue to Blevio with accommodation at Mandarin Oriental, Lake Como.



DAY 2 | BLEVIO - BELLAGIO

Breakfast at hotel. Departure along the inner shore of the lake called the left branch for a short scenic drive up to Bellagio, one of the most beautiful villages on Lake Como. Visit Bellagio and the wonderful gardens of Villa Melzi considered among the most beautiful gardens in Italy and Europe. Return to the hotel in the late afternoon.



DAY 3 | BELLAGIO – MILANO

Breakfast at hotel. Free morning. We recommend the funicular ascent from Como to Brunate for a panoramic view of the lake. Return to Milan in the afternoon.

DESENZANO DEL GARDA E RIVIERA GARDONE

3 days / 2 nights



DAY 1 | MILANO – DESENZANO DEL GARDA

Departure from Milano to Desenzano del Garda with your private car and driver. Visit the Desenzano Castle and walk the waterfront promenade and the lighthouse. Admire the Venetian bridge, one of the most photographed buildings in the city and the houses in typical Venetian style. The tour continues with Gardone Riviera. Settle in your lakeside hotel.

DAY 2 | LAKE GARDA CRUISE

After breakfast, embark on a boat to visit Lake Garda and have a better view of the stunning villas that line the lakeside. In the afternoon wine tasting excursion. Return to the hotel for the evening.

DAY 3 | GARDONE RIVIERA - MILANO

Breakfast at hotel. Free morning to walk through the beautiful lakeside promenade. Visit to the 'Vittoriale degli Italiani' - where Gabriele D'Annunzio lived, before returning to Milano in the late afternoon.

FROM MILANO TO VERONA

10 days / 9 nights



DAY 1 | MILANO

Private transfer to your hotel. Rest of the day at leisure. Hotel Four Seasons Milan.

DAY 2 | MILANO

See the famous sites like the Duomo and the Last Supper with private guide. Go inside the Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II. Stroll around and have an aperitivo in the canal area of Naviglio Grande.

DAY 3 | MILANO - LAKE COMO

Transfer to Lake Como. Rest of the day at leisure. Hotel Grand Hotel Villa Serbelloni

DAY 4 | LAKE COMO

Rent a boat for incredible view of Lake Como. Visit Villa Melzi or Villa Carlotta. Go to the wine bar Enoteca Cava Turaccio.

DAY 5 | LAKE COMO - BERGAMO

Explore the old town (Città Alta) and fall in love with the pretty buildings, cute market square, and lovely and stylish Italian people. Walk the Venetian Walls and enjoy the views from there. Pay a visit to Cappella Colleoni. The beautiful interior makes this a travel highlight.

DAY 6 | BERGAMO - LAKE GARDA - SIRMIONE

With its pretty old town and the harbor, Sirmione is perfect for nice walks.

DAY 7 | SIRMIONE - LIMONE SUL GARDA

Explore Limone (one of the cutest villages in Europe) and bring your camera. The harbor, the pretty houses, and the flowers everywhere make this place picturesque and charming. Head from Limone to Malcesine via boat in the afternoon. The boat ride is fun, and you get to see another beautiful town of Lake Garda.

DAY 8 | LIMONE SUL GARDA - BOLZANO

The city of Bolzano deserves a visit both from a tourist point of view and for the great artistic-cultural contribution. This can be observed at the Museum of Modern and Contemporary Art; the Museum of Natural Sciences and, above all, the South Tyrolean Archaeological Museum, which houses "Ötzi, the man who came from the ice". It is a mummy found in 1991 on Mount Similaun on the border between Alto Adige and South Tyrol. An exceptional archaeological find that has allowed us to know much more in depth the uses and customs of the Copper Age in the Alps.

DAY 9 | BOLZANO AND ITS SURROUNDING

Visit Bolzano surroundings, including Merano and Brunico.

FROM MILANO TO VERONA

10 days / 9 nights



DAY 10 | BOLZANO - VERONA

Verona is an absolutely amazing city. While it is mostly known as the setting for Shakespeare's "Romeo and Juliet", it has so much to offer to its visitors.

DAY 11 | VERONA - MILANO

The tour ends with the airport transfer for your flight home.





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
